 - Memorial Day - Flags were passed out to be placed on Veteran's stones.

 - (3.) Johnston Cemetery - Whitehouse Road - Needs more work than the Drew's can do. Added to ROTC summer repair list.
 - Cemetery Adoption Cards - All set to go out.
 - It was brought up that the cemetery on the left after Roberts Ridge Road needs repairs. (Unknown Warren?)
 - John Hill Cemetery - Vandalized last year- completely repaired. No one knows who fixed it. Fence to be painted by ROTC cadets. (NOTE): John Hill Cemetery was visited by Kelly Mayo on May 13th. She reports that the cemetery has not been repaired and that there is only 1 stone left standing. (Is this the same cemetery that Jeannie was talking about?)
 - Chris Gionest was introduced by Kelly Mayo as a new cemetery committee member.
 - Has everyone turned in their papers to the Town Hall?
 - Meeting was adjourned at 8:30 p.m. Next meeting is scheduled for June 8th.
