Building Committee: Tom reported that the committee met last Monday and have been in touch with Doug Foglio, who is creating a letter to formally donate land to the town, stipulating that it is for a library and must be a working library within five years. The committee is developing a brochure outlining donor levels as well as a task list.

Friends report: Brigit reported that the book sale netted \$220. The fundraiser/dance now has a committee. Six out of eight members who attended the last meeting of the Waterboro Association of Businesses agreed to donate \$50 each to the walkathon. The project is moving forward.
