SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES March 8, 1988

CHARLES CRESSEY: Charlie wanted to come before the Board to discuss a problem that he had with Mr. Marsh at the dump. Mr. Marsh told Charlie that he lived in Waterboro and was cleaning out his cellar, the truck he was using was from Gorham. Charlie asked him for his license to show that he lived in Waterboro. Mr. Marsh got very upset. Stoney had also asked to see his license. Charlie stated that he did not have a sticker, was bringing in white goods, refrigerator, hot water tank, stove that was mixed in with other rubbish. He swore at Charlie so Charlie swore back. ANDREW TIMMIS: The Selectmen okayed the letter to CMP. Andrew has been approached by three engineering firms on water systems. He will be meeting with DEP on Friday to discuss it. Each firm is willing to come in and present their firm to the Selectmen. Selectmen Abbott would like to know what DEP will have to say about what firm is hired. The Board feels that the test drilling should be done at site #2. Andrew has not been able to attend Regional Waste meetings due to conflict with Planning Board meetings. Board contacted Frank Allen and he will attend the next Regional Waste meeting.

MARK CALDWELL: Mark explained to the Board about the church in South Waterboro. The parsonage exempt was moved from the house down accross from the Post Office to the house beside the church. Mark thought the parsonage was ready before April 1 of last year but it was not. Building beside the church is on the fine line of being taxable. Mark feels it should be taxed. The new parsonage has been remodeled and has a new assessment. The church would like the house beside the church totally exempt and \$20,000. exemption on house accross the Post Office. In 1988 the house accross the Post Office will be fully taxable due to being sold so parsonage exemption will be given to house beside church.
