SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES May 10, 1988

Board held a Public Hearing on the dump to get ideas on how the dump should be managed. Many ideas were brought up. Some included, set certain days for the white goods area, more attendents or a different attendent, different parts of Town going using the dump on certain days, when the compactor goes down possible closing the dump. Another hearing was set for June 21st.

ANSEL HAMMOND: Ansel has received a copy of the letter that Karen Lovell sent to the Board regarding the Sunday sales petition. Gary Wood from MMA stated that as long as the intent of the voters was on the petition is was okay to change the wording for the referendum ballot. Question is do they run with the petition or do they repetition with the correct wording. Selectmen Woodsome made a motion to check and see if the referendum question can be reworded according to State Statues and if the Town need a letter from Hammond's stating that they agree with the rewording.

Board voted unanimously to amend the parking ordinance to include no parking both sides of Route 5 and the Town House Road for a distance of 35 feet. Also the East Shore Road, no parking either side in the Town right-of-way.

Board signed the warrant for payment of bills and payroll. The Board also signed CEO, Asst. CEO, Health Officer, Asst. Plumbing Insp., Lions Center Board of Director appointment papers.
