REPORT OF STANDING COMMITTEES:
Dwayne Morin presented the Board with a contract from DEP and one for CMP which the Board signed. The Board discussed and voted to have signs out front of the office building with meeting dates and times. The Board also discussed the new weekly paper Smart Shopper. Due to the prices and the layout, the Board voted that from this date all advertising for the Town will be put into the Smart Shopper not the Budget Saver. Dwayne also talked to the Board the reason why insurance bids are not being sent out. Chm. Abbott told Dwayne that las year 24 bids were sent out and only two companies presented a bid and the Board went with their same insurance company due to the bid prices. Chm. Monteith made the motion to approve the application. Sell. Allen seconded. Voted, passed. The Board signed and approved the application.
