The State has agreed to replace the sidewalk and M & H Logging will pay for half. The cement sidewalk will be replace with asphalt. Sebago Technics is working on the compost and ash spreading license. Dwayne will be meeting with Karen Lovell concerning the illegal subdivision on the Goodwin Mills Road. The State will be done to look over the property that the Town is interested in purchasing from Steve Kasprzak, but it doesn't look there will be any grant money available to purchase it.

NEW BUSINESS:

The Board voted to release a memo to all department heads that all accounts are to take a 10% cut due to the cash flow problem. They are not to spend more than 90% of the money appropriated.

The Board signed the warrant for payment of bills and payroll.
