NEW BUSINESS:

Bob Gobeil asked the Board about the door on the salt shed located on the Old Alfred Road. The door is about to come off the hinges. Sel. Monteith states that it comes under the Road Commission. Chm. Abbott asked what was in the building. Bob told them that the tractor and trailer and there are some other items also. Board will talk to Fred.


BOB WELCH: The Board asked Bob in to discuss his bid on the town report. He had submitted the lowest bid. He presented the Board with some samples of what he has done in the past. He told the Board that the town reports that he is showing them was done by him but when he worked for a different company. He has only been in business since January. He has a company out of Portland that will fold and staple it and the price that he submitted included the folding and stapling. Looking at a delivery date of May 20th with a deadline for camera ready to him by May 8th. The Board voted to award the printing of the Annual Town Report.

The Board discussed installing power to the new concession stand at Friendship Park. The building was built by Waterboro Youth League and now there is not a Waterboro Youth League but a Shaker Valley Little League. Bob Gobeil asked if Parks & Rec. could request that the power be installed. The Board told him that if Parks & Rec. want the power hooked up then it will come out of one of their accounts to pay for the electricity. It is Parks & Rec.'s building and if they want the power installed then they can.

The Board signed the warrant for payment of bills and payroll
