

SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES
March 28, 2006

ATTENDING: Robert Fay, Cindy Moore, Dwayne Woodsome, Nancy Brandt, Pam Witman, Jonathan Raymond, Willis Lord, Ron Perro, Fred Fay, Tom Blackburn, Ray Davis and Evan Grover.

Selectman Fay called the meeting to order at 7:10 pm.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Motion by Selectman Moore and seconded by Selectman Fay to allow Selectman Woodsome and Selectman Fay serve on the Contract Zoning sub-committee. Vote unanimous.
2. Motion by Selectman Fay and seconded by Selectman Woodsome to follow the chairs recommendation to trade in the town tractor for a new tractor. Vote unanimous.
3. Motion by Selectman Woodsome and seconded by Selectman Moore to approve the warrant as printed and all budget articles approved by a majority of the board with the exception of article 29 and that there be no recommendation on that one. Vote unanimous.
4. Motion by Selectman Woodsome and seconded by Selectman Moore that the GP Zone change be put on the warrant and that the second half, uses, not go as it was not done correctly. Vote unanimous.

OLD BUSINESS

1. Selectman Fay noted that they have had a couple more people express interest in the land trust board.
2. Selectman Fay stated that they have agreed to reconvene the Lake Arrowhead Committee but will wait until after Town Meeting

HEARING OF DELEGATION

1. Evan Grover expressed concerns regarding the warrant being sent out with information not completely correct. Stated that the recycling rates do not include the private haulers which they did in July when the recycling numbers were lower. Feels the public should have accurate information. Willis stated that the percentage is based on what RWS reports and the private haulers are in a different category. Evan stated that he is not accusing Willis of deceiving anyone.
