Town Administrator Gary Lamb's report was delivered as follows:

- ➤ <u>DOT Route 5 paving update</u> During summer 2019, Route 5 overlay paving will occur from just north of Subway/Dunkin Donuts entrance to the Townhouse Road intersection, a distance of 1.6 miles. In addition, paving will occur from Dollar General north 2.56 miles
- ➤ Water District Emergency Tabletop exercise Maine Rural Water Association is working with our water district, Maine Drinking Water Program and DEP to plan and conduct an emergency tabletop exercise here to identify strengths and weaknesses of emergency preparedness and response capabilities. The initial planning meeting is from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. tomorrow here in town hall. The actual date and time of the exercise is to be determined, but will probably take up a 4-6 hour time period on the day it is conducted.
- ➤ <u>Budget Committee update</u> meeting #4 is this Thursday 4:30 p.m. and then back to Mondays at 4:30 p.m. until the next Monday holiday.
- <u>June 11, 2019 Election</u> nomination papers will be available on March 13th and must be turned in by April 26th.
