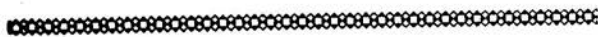

REPORT OF THE SUPERINTENDENT.

To the Superintending School Committee and Citizens of the town of Waterboro:

I submit for your consideration my eighth annual report of the schools of Waterboro.

During the past year eight schools have been maintained with no appreciable change in registration or attendance. The last report to the Department of Education shows an enrollment of 95 boys and 108 girls, a total of 203. Average attendance for the year, -176.07.

There have been three changes in the teaching staff. Mrs. Dorothy Dunnells resigned the Old Corner position in June and Miss Helen Dunnells of Newfield was elected to fill the vacancy. The vacancy caused by the resignation of Miss Harriet Osborne from the East Waterboro Grammar school was filled by Mrs. Vernor Libby. Miss Laura Shurtleff was obliged to resign from the South Waterboro Primary during the present term owing to illness and that school is being taught by Mrs. Elwin Morey of Alfred.

No radical changes have been made in the course of study. At South Waterboro, through the efforts of the teachers, considerable progress has been made in the matter of instruction in music. Music is a worth-while subject in the curriculum and its instruction should be encouraged in every way.

Our buildings are at all times in good condition. May I take this opportunity to express my appreciation of the thorough and painstaking manner in which our janitor, Mr. Fred Berger, performs his duties. Among minor re-

pairs and changes during the year, we have provided dressing rooms in the gymnasium.

It has been impossible to finance the schools within the appropriations. Until last year we had carried a large balance in both elementary and high school accounts. The elementary school balance was used up and the account overdrawn at the end of the fiscal year closing February 15, 1927. Although a thousand dollars was appropriated to offset the previous balance of \$962.58, provision was not made for the new room which had been opened at the South Waterboro school the previous month. There have also been conveyance problems which were not anticipated. A glance at the financial statement will show that the common school overdraft is, in a measure, offset by balances in other departments.

For an account of the work accomplished in the high school, I would refer you to the report of the principal.

In conclusion, I wish to express to the members of the Superintending School Committee, to the teachers and to citizens of the town, my appreciation of their loyalty and support during the past year.

REPORT OF HIGH SCHOOL.

To the Superintendent of Waterboro Schools:

I have the honor to submit my third annual report of Waterboro High School.

As predicted in my last report we have a larger enrollment at the present time than we had a year ago, due to the fact that the graduating class of 1927 numbered only six, while the entering class has nearly three times that number. It is gratifying to note that only four of the total enrollment have left the school, and three of those are attending school elsewhere.

The larger enrollment necessitated the purchase of a considerable amount of new equipment, especially text books. The same condition will prevail next year, for with alternating subjects and ever increasing numbers, the size of the classes is so large that each Fall finds a lack of books. There will also be a need for more apparatus for use in the course in Physics.

One of the long felt needs of the school has been a convenient athletic field and playground. Last Fall, through the generosity of some of the townspeople, a large plot of land back of the school building was cleared of stumps, and plowed. This Spring, work will be continued on the land when a base-ball diamond will be laid out, tennis courts will be made, and if our present plans materialize, playground equipment will be purchased which may be added to each year.

I would like to mention for the consideration of all who may read this report, the advisability of improving

the appearance of the lawn between the building and the street. We no longer need it for a playground. We do need to have it plowed and seeded, cleared of all unsightly trees, and shrubs and an attractive driveway made. These improvements would add greatly to the appearance of the grounds.

In closing, I wish to thank you for your support during the past year.

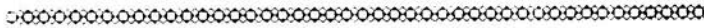
