## REPORT OF THE WATERBORO PLANNING

### BOARD FOR 1971

The Waterboro Planning Board meets on the second Wednesday of the month, usually at Rollins Solution offices. Several special meetings have been held in addition to these regular meetings.

The board has obtained preliminary rough sketch plans from two different engineers to get ideas for a municipal building. Their aim is to have some kind of proposal ready for the annual town meeting.

A Committee from the fire department worked with the board to plan a method of numbering the cottages around Ossipee Lake. This would be a great help for the fire department, and enable them to speed up the location of a fire or other emergency around the lake.

We have worked with the selectmen and interested cottage owners to get an Ossipee Lake Association started, to fight pollution in the lake.

A biologist from Nason College was engaged to obtain chemical samples of Carpenter Brook, to use for future reference standards if needed.

The selectmen were urged to include an article in the warrant of a special town meeting this summer to get the town to form a Conservation Commission.

Since early Fall, with the assistance of the York County Regional Planning Commission, the board has been working toward writing up a Comprehensive Plan for the town. This is required by the State now, and if the town does not write it's own, the State will do it, and at considerable cost to the town. At present, we are working on a map of the town which will show the location of all private dwellings, public houses, commercial and industrial buildings, etc., which will be a help in

showing various areas of development. It is hoped the Comprehensive Plan will be ready by late Spring or early Summer.

### SCHOOL ADMINISTRATIVE DISTRICT NO. 57

#### REPORT OF THE SUPERINTENDENT

January 1, 1972

To the Board of School Directors and to the Citizens of School Administrative District No. 57:

Once again the district has experienced an unusually large increase in the number of pupils, with a majority of the new pupils this year coming here from out-of-state. The October 1 count of pupils being educated at district expense was 1560, an increase of 85 pupils. This 6% growth this year brings the total growth since the district was formed in April, 1966, to 44%. Four-fifths of this growth has occurred at a rapid pace since Massabesic High School opened in September, 1969.

This influx of new pupils has already created space problems at Massabesic High School, and at the Waterboro Elementary School, and will create problems at other elementary schools if the growth pattern continues. The winterizing of summer cottages, the construction of new homes, and the development of housing projects and mobile home courts all indicate that both the adult and the school population will continue to grow.

Several federal programs are providing funds for services and/or materials in the district schools this year. The Elementary Secondary Education Act Title II allocation of \$1,564.61 was used for the purchase of additional library books. The ESEA Title I allocation of \$18,580.00 underwrites the cost at the K-6 level of the school nurse, of one special teacher for the full year, and for another remedial teacher for the last half-year. This is the third and final year of funding of the special program at Massabesic High School for vocationally handicapped pupils. The year's allocation for this VOH program is \$13,550.00, which provides the services of a special teacher, plus equipment and instructional materials. The Emergency Employment Act of 1970 provided funds beginning November 1 for an additional teacher to help with the over crowded 3rd and 4th grades at the Waterboro School, and for a custodian-grounds keeper at Massabesic High School. A later allocation provides funds for a remedial reading teacher at the elementary level, and for an assistant teacher to help with study hall and library supervision at Massabesic High School. These latter two positions start January 17. These four EEA positions are funded through this 1971-72 school year, but there is no indication whether they will be continued beyond this year. Due to changed regulations, we will not qualify for a grant under NDEA Title III this year.

The balance forward to 1972 for the Operating budget is \$24,611.00, or nearly the same as was brought forward to 1971 (\$25,840.68). Receipts for 1971 were \$8,070.28 greater than had been anticipated, which was chiefly the result of legislation by the special session to provide funds for schools having un-

usual enrollment increases in September, 1970, and because final appropriations by Congress for vocational programs (Home Economics and Business Education) were greater than originally proposed. Expenditures for 1971 were \$5,361.07 less than had been budgeted, which is 4/10 of 1% under the estimate.

The Department of Education has advised that the state average operating cost per pupil increased 9% from the 1969-70 to the 1970-71 school year, and that an increase nearly as large is expected for the 1971-72 school year. Although the final 1972 budget determination has not been made at this writing, it appears that gross expenditures would increase about 6½%. We have the continuing problem of providing services and materials for more pupils in an economic period when salary costs for both certificated and non-certificated personnel are increasing annually, and when just about everything that is purchased costs more this year than it did last year.

In looking forward to the immediate future it is clearly evident that one very pressing problem is the provision of additional school facilities. The Building Committee and the School Directors are studying this problem to determine what to recommend to the citizens.

I wish to thank the school directors, the teachers, and all the many others who contribute to the operation of the schools for their helpfulness and cooperation.

Gentlemen:

We have examined the Statement of Financial Condition of the Town of Waterboro, Maine as of December 31, 1970 and the related statements of general fund surplus and departmental operations for the year then ended.

Our examination was made in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards and accordingly included such tests of the accounting records and such other auditing procedures as we considered necessary in the circumstances.

In our opinion, the accompanying Statement of Financial Condition and related statements of general fund surplus and departmental operations present fairly the financial position of the Town of Waterboro, Maine at December 31, 1970 and the results of its operations for the year then ended, in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles applied on a basis consistent with that of the preceding year.

Art. 6. To see what sum of money the Town will grant and raise for roads and bridges for the year ensuing.

Finance Committee recommends: Excise \$2,000.00; Taxes \$2,000.00.

Art. 7. To see what sum of money the Town will grant and raise for cutting bushes on Town Roads.

Finance Committee recommends: \$1,000.00 Excise.

Art. 8. To see what sum of money the Town will grant and raise for Pond Roads for the year ensuing.

Finance Committee recommends: \$1,000.00 Excise.

Art. 9. To see what sum of money the Town will grant and raise for applying a seal coat of tar on Town Roads.

Finance Committee recommends: \$750.00 Excise; \$750.00 Taxes.

Art. 9a. To see what sum of money the Town will grant and raise for tarring T.R.I. Roads that are built in 1972.

Finance Committee recommends: Excise \$1,000.00; Taxes \$2,000.00.

Art. 10. To see if the Town will grant and raise the sum of \$2,666.00 for State Aid Construction in addition to the amount regularly raised for the care of ways, highways and bridges under the provisions of Titles 23, MRSA, Sections 1101, 1103, or 1104.

Finance Committee recommends: \$2,666.00 Taxes.

Art. 11. To see what sum of money the Town will grant and raise for the support of the poor for the year ensuing.

Finance Committee recommends: \$2,000.00 Taxes.

Art. 12. To see what sum of money the Town will grant and raise to pay for transportation charges on surplus foods.

Finance Committee recommends: \$300.00 Surplus.

Art. 13. To see what sum of money the Town will grant and raise for Incidentals for the year ensuing.

Finance Committee recommends: \$1,000.00 Excise.

Art. 14. To see what sum of money the Town will grant and raise for postage and incidentals, for the Town Planning Board for the year ensuing.

Art. 22. To see what sum of money the Town will grant and raise for the observance of Memorial Day.

Finance Committee recommends: Surplus \$150.00.

Art. 23. To see if the Town will grant and raise the sum of \$3,000.00 to be deposited in a bank, same to be known as Waterboro Building Fund for future use, and that this article appear in every Town Warrant until a sum sufficient has been established to build a municipal building when needed.

Finance Committee recommends: No recommendation.

Art. 24. To see what sum of money the Town will grant and raise for the Waterboro Fire Department for the year ensuing.

Finance Committee recommends: \$7,038.95 Taxes.

Art. 25. To see if the Town will grant and raise \$2,000.00 to be used for a new Fire Engine Fund.

Finance Committee recommends: \$2,000.00 Surplus.

Art. 26. To see if the Town will grant and raise the sum of \$160.00 to be paid to the Waterboro Conservation Commission for the year ensuing.

Finance Committee recommends: \$160.00 Surplus.

Art. 27. To see what sum of money the Town will grant and raise for paying interest charges on tax anticipation notes.

Finance Committee recommends: \$2,000.00 Taxes.

Art. 28. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Collector of Taxes to charge interest at the rate of 2/3% per month on all 1972 unpaid taxes as of November 1, 1972, and to see if the Town will vote to continue the discount methods.

Finance Committee recommends: Ought to pass.

Art. 29. To see what sum of money the Town will grant and raise for street lights and beacons, including Town House Lights for the ensuing year.

Finance Committee recommends: \$2,200.00 Taxes.

Art. 30. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to borrow money on Tax Anticipation.

Finance Committee recommends: Ought to pass.

Art. 31. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to grant and raise to pay the Town's share of Social Security and to pay the State Agency of the Town's share of the cost of Administration: \$100.00 of this amount is Bookkeeping Compensation to Treasurer.

Finance Committee recommends: \$1,000.00 Surplus.

Art. 32. To see what sum of money the Town will grant and raise to pay for Workmen's Compensation Insurance on Town Employees for 1972.

Finance Committee recommends: \$300.00 Surplus.

Art. 33. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to sell and dispose at public auction any tax title property acquired by the Town of Waterboro by mature tax liens sales or sales by said public auction to be advertised in advance by posting notices in four conspicuous places in Town at least 15 days before sale. Also it shall be printed 2 weeks in the Sanford Tribune prior to sale or sales and that the Selectmen execute Quitclaim deeds signed by all three for such property. Same shall be with the understanding that the purchaser be responsible for establishing boundary lines. The Tax Collector shall submit a list of all Tax Title Properties to the Selectmen by the 1st of each year.

Finance Committee recommends: That the Selectmen be instructed to sell all Tax Title Property, at public auction, except those properties deemed best to hold for the overall benefit of the Town of Waterboro. It is also suggested that said auction be held the second Saturday of August.

Art. 34. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to join the Maine Municipal Association.

Finance Committee recommends: \$353.50 Surplus.

Art. 35. To see if the Town will vote to allow all revenues from the Registration or Taxes, derived from snowmobiles, to be placed in a separate account, and be expended by the road commissioner and Fire Chief, for maintenance of all fire roads.

Finance Committee recommends: \$1,000.00 Taxes; \$1,200.00 Excise.

Art. 39. To see if the Town will grant and raise \$500.00 to be paid to the Waterboro Youth League to support boys baseball and girls softball programs.
