This would be a total of $\$ 700$. The motion was seconded and a unanimous decision was in place.

A vote was taken to invite back the same couple who did Karaoke last year at $\$ 200$. All were in favor.

April went to watch a few bands and really enjoyed a band called Unfinished Business. A vote was had to hire the band the night of the fireworks from 6-9 for $\$ 500$. All were in favor.

A vote was taken to have Heather book the Combo/Jump bounce house for $\$ 295$. All were in favor.

Still had not received bids from the firework people. April was following up on that.

## Vendors:

Vinnie Nielson who is a vendor and also on multiple vendor committees also joined our meeting. He offered his help in any way and also had brought forth a Church
organization in Westbrook that is constructing a Human Foosball game and having them come to the event. It would cost the committee nothing and the only costs would be to play. All were in favor. Also he had the idea of getting other organizations and perhaps vendors on board to offer a bike raffle, and in order to collect the bike you needed to be present. This is also no cost to the committee and everyone felt that this would keep attendance during the day up.

A recommendation to have the Sheriff Department have a booth at the Event was discussed. Alec also volunteered to discuss this with them. All were in favor.

## Booklet:

Crystal updated us on the booklet. She had about 8-9 come in and continues to go out and followup. We also brainstormed some new business in the area to ask as well. Also discussed a good opportunity for some of those businesses to sponsor a bike for the raffle.

## Misc:
