The rest of the evening was devoted to examining copies of the simulated Comprehensive Plan drawn up by pupils of S. A. D. 57, passed out by L. Rolling. The general feeling was that after some changes and additions we can use it as a guide and write up a Comprehensive Plan for the Town of Waterboro. Members will takecopies home and write up suggestions for changes to bring to the next meeting.

It was woted that a letter of appreciation from the Board be sent to the Seventh Period Current History Class of Barton Roberts at S. A. D. 57 for the excellent example of a Comprehensive Plan that they wrote. Chairman Woodsome will take care of that.

Stephen Kasprzak's Plan for a development on Webber Road in No. Waterboro Lots 1 through 18 again presented. Since Mr. E. K. Day's letter said he could see no danger of pollution to Ossipee Lake, and we had agreed to ide by his decision, it was decided to approve the plan, and this was done.
