

Public Hearing held March 31, 1973 at Waterboro Town Hall.

Present; Everett Smith, Jr., Selectmen Andrew Woodson, Jr., Stephen Kasprzak, Starr King, and 12 interested townspeople.

Everett Smith, Jr. presided in place of Chairman Clinton Woodson.

The acting Chairman read the entire Comprehensive Plan through to the audience, pausing after each Section to give people a chance to make comments or suggestions.

The only suggestions were to change "district" to "Town" on page 5, 1st, paragraph, 4th line, and to add "Conservation" on page 10, 3rd paragraph, 1st line, so as to read "Conservation Board".

It was also suggested that when we have another hearing, we put out flyers to advertise the fact.

The Town Land Use Map, compiled by the Southern Maine Regional Planning Commission, was on display, and many people seemed interested in it.

Meeting was adjourned shortly after 2:00 PM.
