
John Winslow mentioned that the Conservation Commission has applied for a Ford Foundation Grant to use to map the natural resources of the Town.

Someone had researched the facts that the Town contains 45,600 acres, has 1160 residences, and 4000 parcels of land.

There was discussion of what districts named in the S. M. R. P. C. Model Zoning Ordinance Part II will be needed in a Zoning Ordinance for the Town of Waterboro.

A round table discussion of what parts of Waterboro to zone as Village Districts. General Consensus was that So. Waterboro, East Waterboro, Ctr. Waterboro, And No. Waterboro should probably be named. Each member should try to decide what the boundaries of each district should be, and bring his opinion to the next zoning meeting.
