MINUTES

Regular Meeting

Bill Chipman: Representative from S.M.R.P. in to talk with Selectmen concerning "Unknown" and "Town of Waterboro" lots. Chipman explained the procedure of tracing owners of land through the Registry of Deeds, going back 40 years and then sending a bill and having all paperwork returned to the Town lien produces etc., then the properties in question can be placed in the Town's name legally. Mr. Chipman charges \$10.00 an hour and was hired by the Selectmen to research 3 lots, Map 1-Lot 10, Map 4-Lot 63, Map 15-Lot 9.

York County Health Services: Elaine Mac Cartty, R.N. and George Petty, representatives in for a request of \$2,300. at the Annual Town Meeting. They were advised that they would be called in to discuss the request with the Finance Comm. at a later date. They were also informed that they could use the Town Hall for clinics at any time.

Douglas Foglio: Contractor for snow removal, South Section of Town, in to review the Contract Map. Much discussion held. Westwinds Dev. will be added to his route for a fee of \$400. with the stipulation that if we get so much snow that he has to plow the turn around he will charge extra. Also Foglio will trade the section of Mt. Rd. for additional mileage on the New Rd. Foglio's handwriting on the contract map depicts contract lines, in both red and blue ink, of roads to be plowed by him in the So. Section of Town. Contractor Robert Abbott will meet with the Selectmen Tuesday, Sept. 29th. and will be asked to take the Mt. Rd. on his North Section. Foglio said that he had in the recent years been making one pass through the yard of the Old Elementary School on Rte. 202 in So. Waterboro for fire safety, asked if the Lions planned parking areas there. Monteith said he would check with the Lions at their next meeting.

Two locations are to be cleared before snow fall. The Road Comm., will be notified of the problems at Northwest Pond by Provencher property concerning the turn around, the other on Ossipee Hill road across from the Kelley property.

One Pine St. in So. Waterboro, it was agreed that if Foglio had to shovel out turn around the Town to pay extra.

Hamilton Road will be checked by Middle Branch Engineering to determine if the rocks that have been placed in front of the Hamilton property are in the Town right of way. Selectmen are concerned with snow removal.

Dept. of Transportation to be sent a letter requesting a meeting at the Waterboro Town Hall regarding the reclassification of public highways within the Town.
