MINUTES

Selectmen's Meeting

Present: Chmn. Robert Fay, John Monteith, Andrew Woodsome, Jr.,

Concealed Weapon Permit: Gordon Littlefield, Approved.

Deputy Boyington from the York County Sheriff's Dept. in to discuss the parking problems on Pine Dr. in So, Waterboro.

He was given a copy of the Town of Waterboro's Parking Ordinance and an Amendment to the Ordinance which he will take to the District Atty. for his ruling on the legality of the Ordinance. Boyington also told the Selectmen that any vehicles hindering maintaining or snow removal of a Town Way could be legally towed away.

Road Commissioner, Glenn Bean called to notify the Selectmen that he could not attend the meeting. Chmn. Fay talked with him and told him that he was to have the sand pile located on the Andrew Woodosme, Sr. property in No. Waterboro hauled off. Mr. Woodosme had been contacted by Mr. Fay and it was Woodosme's wish that the sand pile be removed.

Willis Lord: in to sign papers nominating him as candidate in the next Community ASC Committee for York County.

Selectmen voted unanimously to use the remaining balance of \$23,780 in the Basket Ball Program for the Parks and Recreation Comm. to install a skating rink off the Old Alfred road on Town property in E. Waterboro.

ZBA Chmn. Williams requested, for Michael Hammond a type written transcript of the ZBa hearing held Oct. 15, 1981. Selectmen told Mr. Williams the request should be in writing and that the Town's Atty. would be called on a price to charge Mr. Hammond.

Ossipee Hill Road Charles Torno from Stuart, Torno & Stuart Co. in to discuss the Phase I of the Ossipee Hill Rd. Project. Also in attendance Earl Pennell owner of property abutting the Ossipee Hill road where the work will be done and David Silva, representing his father who has purchased a piece of land from Mr. Pennell. A strip of land will be taken from Silva for the widening of the road. Silva is concerned that the road will be much higher in grade than the land. He was assured that lots of fill would be available at the site and would be used to level his lot by the road. Pennell also wants his lot leveled. Large culverts to be placed along the road and extended to put Silva's driveway over it.

Both Pennell and Silva feel that the Selectmen should abate taxes on the property for 5 years to compensate their loss. Selectmen said they felt this would not be legal and would call M.M.A. for an answer. Graphs and maps of the project reviewed with Mr. Torno.
