Waterboro Patent Corp: Chmn. Woodsome reported that he had received a call from Mr. Alan Zion, owner of the property abutting the Town Stump Dump on Bennett Hill Rd. Zion was inquiring about the Town's proposed purchase of additional land for an enlargement of the Stump Dump. Woodsome informed Zion that the Board would not have any idea if the purchase could be made until after the Town's Annual Town Meeting.

Constables: Ed Waterhouse and Chauncey Gerry Town Constables had been asked in to talk to the Selectmen concerning their role in the up coming Halloween Holiday. Chmn. Woodsome said the Board of Selectmen did not want the Constables to take part in any law enforcement, other than if they wanted to or was asked to help out at the Parks & Recreation Comm./ Jaycee's Halloween Party, to be held at the East Waterboro Elementary School. That is only to direct traffic, etc. Constable Gerry said that Dana Blackburn prop. of Graves General Store had asked him to help him that night, to kind of keep an eye on his store. Woodsome said not as a Town Constable.



