Selectmen's Meeting

Chmn. Abbott reported that he had signed paperwork for the Fire Dept. to pick up a piece of equipment at the Suplus Property.

Brunetti's, Inc.: The Board received an application for a license to sell Malt and Vine at the former Jalajac's Restaurant by the Picnic Area on Route 5, the hearing date was set for June 4th. at 7:30 PM.

Scrambles License: The Board signed the first license for this year for a Moto Cross Race at the North Waterboro Scrambles in No. Waterboro.

Speed Bumps: The Board is requesting that the Rd. Commissioner Glenn Bean fill in the speed bump that he installed at the Picnic Area off Route 5 by Ossipee Lake. Bean did not attend this meeting a letter will be sent asking that this be done as soon as possible.

Ossipee Hill Rd.: Selectman Woodsome reported that he had called the Town's Engineer Walt Stinson in regards to the work he said that dirt had been pulled to the side of the road from the ditch in front of the Thompson residence, water still standing in ditch, no running, slope's are covered with hay and very little seed used. Slope's appear to have very little, if any loam on them. Areas that were washed out not fixed, just hay put on. However, the road base of crushed gravel looks good.


Grass Trimmer: The Board voted to purchase a gas powered grass trimmer from F.M. Abbott for Allen Roberts to use in trimming the cemeteries.


