- PRESENT: Chrm Andrew C Woodsome, Jr., Sel Dennis Abbott, Sel Robert Fay.
- PAYROLL: It was agreed by the entire Board not to pay an elected official overtime or time and a half for hours worked over 40. This was instigated by a concern from the Road Commissioner, Fred Fay.
- SYLCO: A call will be made to Sylco Cabinet Makers for an invoice for the new oak desk in the Selectmen's Office. This invoice will be for 475.00
- ELEMENTARY SCHOOL: Chrm Andrew C Woodsoem, Jr has permission from the other 2 Selectmen to have Ed Waterhouse, Rick Smith and 2 High School students set up the Elementary School on Friday March 13, 1987 for the Town Meeting.
- MAINE STATE POLICE: A Sargent form the Maine State Police requested that the Board of Selectmen ask the Saco River Tel and Tel to list the Maine State Police under Waterboro on the inside cover of the Telephone Book. The Board has agreed to add the toll free ploice number to the book under Waterboro and the Sheriffs number.
- BICENTENNIAL LICENSE PLATE: Chrm Woodsome, Jr said that people are having a problem having their vehicles inspected with a Bicentenial license plate on them. He said that Rep Lord submitted the use of these plates as an emergency bill and the Governor has signed it, therefore it has become law. It was suggested that prehaps Rep Lord should put out a press release stating so.
- TOWN DUMP: Sel Abbott said that Mr Stone, the dump attendent, asked him where the Leather Mill should dispose of their hides and hoofs, apparently they dump some off into the dump compactor last week. Sel Abbott told Mr Stone that they are not allowed to dump that material in the compactor. He must take it else where. Sel Abbott also told him not to let people dump horse manure in the compactor either.

 It was suggested that after the Town Meeting the Board of Selectmen meet with Stevens Custom Disposal, and Mr Stone to discuss a set of rules at the dump.

 If a person can show proof that they are residents of Waterboro they can dump at the dump without a sticker, but they should come to the Town Hall and get a sticker.
- RWS: A call will be made to Regional Waste to see what amount the town can expect to receive from the buy back.

PARKS AND RECREATION: Rudy Ross talked to the Board about the work
Foglio Escavating was supposed to do at Friendship
Park, to date this work has not been done. Mr Ross
understands that Foglio is extremely busy. The Board
agreed. Chrm Woodsome, Jr went to to say that he
believes that Foglio was the only one that bid to do
the job and prehaps a meeting sometime after Town

The CEO needs approval on the Flood Plan Ordinance before 6/30/87. Chrm Woodsome, Jr said that all the information needed for this ordinance is not available at this time. Sel Abbott said that most likely the town will have to have a Special Town Mtg to discuss this topic and the last payment to be received from Revenue Sharing. Chrm Woodsome, Jr agreed.

Van Foglio asked to meet with the Board to discuss the Carl Sellers case. Apparently Mr Sellers failed to have Van inspect the building and failed to get occupancy permits. Van wrote to Atty Lovell, she replied that Mr Sellers is in the process of having his subdivision plan and his mylar done. The town does have the authority to pursue the occupancy permit requirement.
