ANDREW TIMMIS:

- 1. He and Health Officer/Plumbing Inspector, Tim Nelson will accompany CA White and J Rand, Town employed Geologist, to Augusta on Friday. Their mission is to try and seek state aid and assistent in the ground water investigation.
- 2. Timmis worked with DEP representative on Monday and Tuesday. The research they are doing is at SMF and the Leather Mill.
- 3. He reported that he has received alot of information he requested from other towns regarding the town's Comprehensive Plan. He will do most of the mapping himself. To save time and money.

PARKS AND RECREATION: Sel Woodsome, Jr told Rudy Ross, Chrm of Parks & Rec, that a fence must be put in around the horseshoe pits. Rudy said that he is working on it with the Ossipee Mountaineers.

MMA: Chrm Fay spoke with Kay Rand from the MMA regarding the 29.90 per pupil grant from the state. This money would go directly to the town's committment from the state.

A special town meeting must be held for the Dept. of Educational & Cultural Services for the 1,825.00 block grant. This will be discussed at a later meeting.

PUBLIC HEARING: Andrew Timmis called a public hearing to discuss the York County 2000 Housing Committee's request for the Town of Waterboro along with 29 other York County towns/cities to committe themselves to having a study done to confirm the fact that this area needs affordable housing. John Downing from the York County 2000 spoke and informed the people at the hearing about this 125.00 dollar committement.

C A WHITE/JOHN RAND/ED BRADLEY: These town employed geologist were in and discussed with the Waterboro citizens the activities they have planned for this area. A survey will be sent out shortly for people to fill out and they will be in the area more and more and look foreward to talking to local people about the water problems and concerns.
