SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES 2/6/90

Regular meeting of the Waterboro Board of Selectmen.

PRESENT: Chairman Andrew C. Woodsome, Jr., Robert C. Fay, Dennis G. Abbott.

NEW BUSINESS:

SEBAGO TECHNICS: Shawn Frank and Don Snow represented Sebago Technics and were in to discuss the survey progress that is being done on Friendship Park. Could be an error in the boundry lines on Milne subdivision. Chm. Woodsome suggested having Steve Kasprzak in to sign a quit claim deed to relinquish any rights he may have. A meeting with Steve Kasprzak, James Carll, Charlie Brown and the Selectmen will be set up sometime towards the end of March.

GEORGE ABBOTT: Mr. Abbott is from North Conway and he came in to discuss taking care of the white goods at the dump. He feels that he can haul for \$175.00 a load about 5 to 6 ton to a load. About \$30.00 a tone. Will keep metal cleaned up. He hauls to Saco Steel and to Waldron's in Scarborough. He estimates that there is about 6-8 loads now at the dump. He will take gas tanks if they are empty. He also would like to haul junk cars if possible for free, he would leave the wheels and tires and gas tanks that contain gas. He would have to have a central area where the tanks are stripped. Beals Equipment charges the town \$40.00 a ton to take care of the white goods now at the dump.

Board voted to pay George Abbott \$8.50 per hour for custodian services. George will make a rake for the tables in the hall and he will also be in charged of all town owned buildings.



Board voted to go with a library in the East School building with the stipulation that the Town retain the building and lease it to the Lioness's for 1 to 5 years and not a 99 year lease.

Board voted to accept the Commercial Hauler Ordinance.

Board signed the warrant for payment of bills and payroll.
