## REPORT OF STANDING COMMITEES:

Dianne Holden came before the Board to discuss with them a letter that she has received from the Attorney General's office concerning Lionel Belanger's excise tax. Dianne had received a call from Nancy Myers from Bureau of Taxation stating that she had received a call from Saco that Lionel Belanger has been over paying his excise taxes for the last four years. He originally paid the excise to Saco and when he did the reregistration in Waterboro, Waterboro went by what Saco had figured out.
