SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES 11/6/90

Regular meeting of the Waterboro Board of Selectmen.

PRESENT: Chm. Robert C. Fay, Dennis G. Abbott, John C. Monteith.

REPORT OF STANDING COMMITTEES:

Jerry Pare came in to discuss with the Board the dispersal of reimbursement money for the Fire Dept. and Rescue. With the Town paying them individually they have to pay taxes due to being added to their salary. Would rather have a check made out to the Fire Dept. and the dept. pay the reimbursements and they would also like to have quarterly payments. Anyone who receives over \$600.00 the IRS has to be notified. Sel. Monteith does not recommend giving the whole allotment but would quarterly and will discuss it with Chm. Fay and Sel. Abbott. Jerry told Sel. Monteith that they would submit a bill with everyone's name, amount due for reimbursement and how many calls they responded to. Sel. Monteith does not like the idea that someone can take a portion of their salary without first putting in any time. At this time Sel. Abbott entered the meeting and Sel. Monteith updated Sel. Abbott on the conversation with Jerry. Sel. Abbott told Jerry that he would like to see monthly payments and not once a year but he has reservations about cutting a check to the Fire Dept. to do the reimbursing. The Board will set up a meeting with Joel Patterson to meet with the Fire Dept. and Board of Selectmen to discuss what can be done. Jerry also questioned the request for inventory. The Fire Dept. was told by the Finance Comm. and it was voted in at Town Meeting that the Dept. send out bids for insurance and the Dept. did and know have a policy for three years. They do not have the information on hand and it would take a while to compile all the information requested.

VAN FOGLIO: Van came in to discuss with the Board about a zoning problem. Mr. Cleveland created an illegal subdivision. He now has had new deeds made out and has rectified the problem. His house sits in Village Zone and the rest of his property in in the AR Zone. He deeded one acre lots to his sons even after Van told him that he couldn't. He kept the one acre lot with the house and added an apartment in the basement. He now has been deeded back four acres. Van has told him that he needs to pay a fine and his recommendation of a fine is for the minimal amount of \$1500. Sel. Abbott questions what right does the Town have to fine him when he fixed the situation on his own and Van should talk to Karen Lovell. Sel. Monteith agreed with Sel. Abbott.

Board signed the warrant for payment of bills and payroll.
