SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES April 23, 1991

Regular meeting of the Waterboro Board of Selectmen.

PRESENT: Chm. Robert C. Fay, Dennis G. Abbott, John C. Monteith.

REPORT OF STANDING COMMITTEES:

The Board discussed the proposal submitted by Parks & Rec. concerning Rte. 5 parking. Their proposal is for Fri., Sat., and Sun. Chm. Fay has concerns if only having a Sheriff or Constable there on weekends is going against the town meeting vote, and if a vote is needed to change it to just the weekends.

Dwayne Morin discussed several things with the Board. The Board will be discussing the revised dog ordinance at their meeting next Tuesday. Also went over the bids for Clarks Bridge Road, Foglio, Inc. submitted a bid of \$16,610, and Leighton Excavation submitted a bid for \$44,450. Dwayne also pointed out to the Board that the plans show the underdrain to be only 30 inches below ground when it should be four feet due to the frost. Presented the Board with the bids submitted for curbside pickup. SSR was the lowest bidder at \$55,100. The transfer station now costs \$65,000. a year. DEP is coming down tomorrow at 9:30 to inspect the dump. Also went over what the minimum bids should be for the Lake Arrowhead lots being offered to the abutters. Lake Arrowhead has informed the Town that any lots sold, if there are any back dues on the lots, the buyer will have to pay the back dues. Board suggests starting the minimum bid at \$2,500. Dwayne will bring back to the Board next week a proposal for the lots. Board also went over the accounts. There is a problem with three accounts. CEO has a deficit of \$357. but there are some revenues that have not been applied yet, Office Supplies balance is very low, the Board suggested to Dwayne to hold all bills for thirty days. Parks & Rec. has \$400. left and will need \$600. for umpires.

The Board voted in a new policy concerning liquor license applications. The Board will not sign the application until all the bills pertaining to the public hearing for that application has been paid.

The Board also voted to hold a Candidates Night on Council Meeting night on May 21st at 7:00 p.m.

Board signed the warrant for payment of bills and payroll.

The Board at this time adjourned to the Town Hall to conduct this month's council meeting.
