NEW BUSINESS:

A request for use of Friendship Park has been made by Shellie Newton for a wedding reception on July 13th. The Board approved the usage of Friendship Park.

DWAYNE MORIN: Dwayne went over some accounts with the Board. stump dump account is overdrawn by \$123. The Board reviewed the account and approved to use the white goods account for some of the bills. Dwayne also presented a chart for the Selectmen for Town The Board signed the contract between the Town and the Meeting. SAD #57 has called and would like a recycling Sheriff's Dept. container at the school next year. The Board asked Dwayne to have Nettie John com in to talk to them about it. Dwayne also updated the Board on the Rose Lowe property. M & H Logging has demobilized and will cost the Town \$7,000. to come back in Town. They will be back to patch the roads. Dwayne also informed the Board that he has received the paperwork from the State on the road in front of Brunetti's Restaurant. The Board questions why it is being done, the rest of the road was bought for one dollar, no gain for the Town, it gives the land to the restaurant. The owners of the restaurant has stated that they will give the Town a perpetual easement. The Board suggests having the Town Attorney review and make suggestions. Board has concerns if the Town discontinues it and then turn it over to the Restaurant, what happens if they don't pave it and people can't get to the boat ramp. Chm. Fay suggests making it a Town road and giving the restaurant an easement. Dwayne showed the Board samples of rugs for the foyer both in the Town Hall and the office area. Board approved the purchase of the rugs for both foyers.

VAN FOGLIO: Van came in to discuss the Raymond Chappel problem. He has not answered the letter that was sent to him concerning junk cars. The Board told Van to contact the Town Attorney and have them handle it.
