SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES SEPTEMBER 20, 1994

Regular meeting of the Waterboro Board of Selectmen.

PRESENT: Chm. Dennis G. Abbott, John C. Monteith and Robert C. Fay. Also present; Selectmen's Assistant Dwayne Morin and Parks & Rec. Chm. Bob Gobeil.

REPORT OF STANDING COMMITTEES:

DWAYNE MORIN: Discussed salt for the upcoming winter season. Dwayne will contact Shurtleff on the salt and also send out the sand bids. Chm. Abbott asked if the Middle Road was completed yet and Dwayne told the Board that he was told that it was. Board discussed road projects. The Board requests that the Road Commissioner fill out a work plan for the following week for the Board to approve. Dwayne reported that the Ross Corner Road project was overspent by \$150. Board voted for the \$150. to dome out the Road and Bridges account. Also the Road Commissioner, Glenn Bean, Sr., recently purchased a saw for \$467, without prior approval or with a purchase order. The Board has concerns over the road projects. One project is not being finished before another one is started. This week there was approximately \$9,000, spent on roads. The Board voted that no more road projects be started until next week, when the Road Commissioner meets with the Board of Selectmen and brings the Board up to date on the projects. Board also has concerns over paying \$75. an hour for a tractor when the towns is not being used. Refrigerators: Board voted that Commercial Haulers and Hollis Residents will be charge \$10.00 for each refrigerator disposed of at the transfer station or Hollis may have the freon removed from the refrigerators before disposing of at the transfer station. Have received a letter from Jack Murphy and he suggests on the curve on rout 5 to petition the state for have the road fixed for safety improvements and he is willing to do the petition. Board voted to have Mr. Murphy start the petition process. Easement: Andrew Woodsome, Jr. has agreed to an easement for the culvert on his property and the developer is willing to pay for half of the costs.
