Mrs. Graffam explained that she had been before the board in February requesting that her road be plowed. According to the road book, the town plows 2/10 of a mile which would be in front of her property, however, they actually plow only 1/10 of a mile. The Road Commissioner stated that the reason for not plowing the full 2/10 is that there is not enough room to turn around. It was also explained that it was not included in the contract and she is requesting that before another contract is entered into that it be included. She purchased her property based on the fact that she was told it was a town maintained road. She also stated that they have sanded and if can do that then can also plow. Willis explained the difference between sanding and plowing. Will send the Road Commissioner down to look at the road and have an answer for her by next week. Mrs. Graffam stated that her mortgage stipulates that the road is maintained.
