

## **SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES**

### **May 22, 2001**

### **NEW BUSINESS**

1. Chose the following winners in the Recycling Banner Contest: Jennifer Collupy, 1<sup>st</sup> Place, Haley White, Honorable Mention and Devon Locke, Special Award.
2. Motion by Bob and seconded by Willis to close the Transfer Station on Memorial Day. Vote 3-0-0.
3. Motion by Bob and seconded by Willis to hire Joel Patterson as the towns auditor. Vote 3-0-0.

### **OTHER**

1. Motion by Bob to interview two more applicants for the Planning Board and to keep the position open until June 15<sup>th</sup>. Brenda stated that a deadline was clearly set for April 30<sup>th</sup>. Willis stated that if keeping that open should open to everyone. Noted that the two new candidates are brand new. 2. Has a request for cellphones from both ACO's. Selectmen agreed that Nancy could look into it and do whatever she felt was necessary. Discussed looking into coverage for during the day.
3. Reported that they have hired for the beach area.
4. Discussed painting crosswalks. Will talk with Fred and find out if the funds are there to do it.
5. Received contract from the Kennebunk shelter.
6. Discussed the increase in the mileage allowance. Brenda stated that it was her understanding that the last vote was that it would be whatever the IRS standard was. Will increase to \$.345 per IRS standard.
