August 14, 2001

OTHER

1. John Littlefield reported that the fire danger is very high. Recommended closing the burn pit until the fire danger comes back down. Will close the pit for now. Also reported that they will not be burning the Charland house because of the fire danger. The Sanford police dept. is going in on Friday to do training. Did go look at the aerial truck in New York. Cost would be \$20,000 and would cost an additional \$20,000 to repair and certify it. Did talk him down to \$19,000. Will be speaking to the Finance Committee tomorrow night. It is a 1980 Mack with 10,413 miles on it. Has checked with the leasing company and they are willing to finance it. Reported that they have sent the literature to the printer for the subscription plan. Requested address labels for each taxpayer in town. Explained how the subscription plan works. Reported that they took 12 applications in the last month for volunteers to the department. Explained that the only expense incurred for the training on Saturday was \$6.00 to each fire fighter who participated in the training. John explained that the reason the town can't burn painted or treated wood and the fire department can is because they are exempt for training. Discussed controlled burns at the transfer station with the fire department.
