NEW BUSINESS

1. Wendy discussed a program that collects old cell phones and Motorola reconditions them for distribution to families of domestic violence. Requested permission to have the town hall as a collection site for people to drop off their old phones. Motion by Willis and seconded by Eric to allow town hall to be a collection site for the cell phones and that Wendy be in charge and then in her absence whoever fills in for General Assistance. Voted. Passed.
2. Tabled the vote to approve the new road name until they can get more information. Feel that it should not be initials and discussed drawing up a policy requiring that roads have names and not just letters or numbers.
3. Motion by Willis and seconded by Eric to pass and sign the Protection from Harassment Order listed as Item #3 on the 7/23/02 Selectmen's Meeting Agenda. Voted. Passed.
4. Motion by Eric and seconded by Willis to accept the recommendation of the Transfer Station Manager and to send a letter to the individual by certified mail and to suspend his transfer station privileges for 6 months from the date the letter is received. Voted. Passed.

OTHER

1. Discussed how to handle the beach area. Not everyone needs a dump sticker and should not have to purchase one just to use the beach area. Discussed going by a license or registration. Also discussed having a separate sticker just for the beach area.
2. Motion by Willis and seconded by Eric to accept the minutes of 7/16/02 as written. Voted. Passed.
3. Willis read the list of reminders.
4. Clint Andrews presented some information on the tires that were just shipped out. Cost for 2 loads was \$1,321. There are still a couple of loads left at the Transfer Station.
5. Teresa Lowell reported that there is an abandoned car on Middle Road. Will turn this over to the Sheriff's Dept.
6. Doug reported that they just received the contract for next years fireworks. Would like to see some businesses in town contribute and perhaps they could be even bigger and better.
