IN MEMORIAM

Raymond H. Bradeen was born in North Waterboro, Maine on March 20, 1896, the son of Henry L. and Harriet Lord Bradeen.

He died on October 4, 1970 at the Goodall Hospital in Sanford, Maine after a short illness.

Raymond and his wife, the former Ethel M. Durgin, lived at North Waterboro for many years, on the site where he was born.

He was a graduate of Waterboro High School. He later graduated from Burdett College and the Bentley School of Accounting and Finance of Boston and was an accountant by profession.

He was auditor of the town books of Waterboro and served as a School Committee, tax collector and treasurer.

He was a Representative in the 1951, 1961 and 1963 legislatures where he was appointed to the Joint Committee on Education and the Legislative Taxation Committee.

He was a 32nd degree Mason, a member of Freedom Lodge, A.F. and A.M. of Limerick, Kora Temple Shrine of Lewiston and Brown-Emmons Post, American Legion of Alfred.

He served in the U.S. Army in World War I.

He gave freely of his time and ability to the public service and with the passing of Raymond H. Bradeen the State of Maine and the Town of Waterboro lost a dedicated citizen who will not soon be forgotten. Town of Waterboro

ANNUAL REPORT OF PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING SERVICE IN WATERBORO IN THE YEAR 1970

Public health nursing is a special field of nursing that combines the skills of nursing and public health for the promotion of health, prevention of illness and disability and rehabilitation.

The health picture of the nation has changed considerably during the last decade. Due to research many diseases can now be prevented by immunization. When the immunization level is high, epidemics should not occur. Because of our attempts to eradicate some diseases through immunizations, such diseases as diphtheria, whooping cough, tetanus, polio, smallpox and more recently, measles and German measles are on their way to being diseases of the past.

For many years our efforts have been directed to the health care of infants and preschool children through Child Health Conferences.

Two conferences were held with a total attendance of twentytwo. Only four took advantage of the physical examination offered. The following immunizations were given:

SCHOOL ADMINISTRATIVE DISTRICT NO. 57 REPORT OF THE SUPERINTENDENT

January 1, 1971

To the Board of School Directors and to the Citizens of School Administrative District No. 57:

One of the most significant developments of the past year was the unusually large increase last September in pupil enrollments, 11% more pupils attending district schools than for the previous fall. Some of this growth was due to the differential between a small graduating senior class and a large incoming kindergarten class, and the balance was due to many new families moving into the district. Cumulative growth of pupil enrollments is now 36.6% over what it was when the district was formed in 1966. The following graph is utilized to illustrate not only the total growth but also to show the current trend of rapid increase.

It is good to see the evident pride which the citizens and parents take in the successful operation of the new elements of the district's school system,—Massabesic High School and the Kindergarten program. Everyone must realize that adequate financial support is imperative if the quality and the scope of the present program is to be maintained or improved. We have a school system which is growing in an economic period when the prices of services and materials are constantly

Title I federal funds under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 were utilized to provide school nursing and special help teaching services at the elementary level, and Title II monies were approved for the purchase of additional library books. A grant of Vocational Funds was received for a special project to assist with the vocational education of handicapped pupils at the high school.

Twenty-five Junior and Senior pupils take their academic courses at Massabesic High School and attend one-half of each day at the Regional Technical and Vocational Center at Sanford High School. Transportation is provided between the two schools.

The increase in the gross budget and also in the appropriations reguired to support the budget are in the average range of those reported in the press to date. Our teacher salary schedules again are slightly below the average, as are also the hourly wage rates for non-certificated personnel. There are no new programs in the 1971 budget, however we are asking for restoration of the music and art programs at the elementary level. These two positions were eliminated as a result of the budget cut last year. We also need an additional first grade teacher at Waterboro, and two more teachers at Massabesic High School because of pupil enrollment increases.

The district is fortunate to have a balance forward to 1971 of \$25,840.68. Total expenditures for 1970 were \$1,592.63 less than authorized by the voters, however receipts were \$24,248.05 larger than were anticipated. When the budget was prepared Congress had refused to appropriate any PL 874 funds, and we were advised by federal officials not to depend on any PL 874 money. Funds were appropriated later in the year however, and we finally received \$9,653. Reimbursement of interest paid in anticipation of state aid netted an additional \$5,911.26. The Business Education program received vocational approval, with reimbursement of \$3,700 and new legislation brought in \$3,386.37 for pupils from a tax-exempt institution (New Life Centers, Inc., in Limerick.)

One new 'bookkeeping' factor requires offsetting entries in both receipts and expenditures of \$127,317 for debt service without actually affecting the net budget. Originally the state was to pay the state construction aid directly on Massabesic High School, but later legislation required that the state pay the money to the district, and that the district then make the payment.

In closing may I express appreciation to the district staff and the school directors for their interest, cooperation and valuable assistance.
